The **2014 Jingle Bell Run/Walk for Arthritis** will take place on **Saturday, December 6**. It's going to be an exciting day full of fun, family and a community celebration as we move closer to a cure for arthritis. Here are some important details about the event.

Location

This year's event will take place at **Burnett Park** located at 501 W. 7th Street Fort Worth, TX 76102.

Parking

Parking in the **Burnett Plaza Parking Garage** is free. The Burnett Plaza Parking Garage is located at 800 Cherry Street Fort Worth, TX 76102, directly behind Burnett Plaza. Both entrances and exits will be open for your convenience.

Are you a Jingle Bell Run/Walk VIP? If you raised **\$1,000 by December 2**, you are! Individuals who qualify for the festive VIP area will be given wrist bands as they check in, either at packet pick-up or on race day (Sponsors, Top Walkers, Top Donors and Top Teams).

Dogs Welcome

Dogs on leashes are welcome to join you in the Jingle Bell Run/Walk for Arthritis. Dog owners are welcome to bring their dogs along, provided they follow a few simple rules. 1) All dogs must be on a leash at all times. 2) Dogs must be current on vaccinations. 3) Dogs must be comfortable around crowds, noise, other dogs and children. 4) Dog owners must register their dog at registration in the dog zone, and sign a dog waiver. (If you've registered your pup on-line, your waiver is already complete.

Please remember to clean up after your dog to help keep the event clean for all participants.

Strollers Welcome

Strollers are welcome; we want all ages to enjoy the Jingle Bell Run/Walk for Arthritis! Please be mindful of our runners and walkers, and line up toward the back of the start corrals.

Safety

Police, volunteers, cones, and signs will be all along the race route to help you stay the course. We will be running on active city streets, so please exercise the utmost caution and follow the instructions given. [Click here for our course map.](#)
