Board Certified Rheumatologist

Dr. Susan Lemon is a board certified Rheumatologist with 9 years of experience practicing at Sansum Clinic in Santa Barbara, California. She has offices in both Santa Barbara and Solvang. Her busy practice focuses on the treatment of all types of degenerative and autoimmune arthritis conditions. Dr. Lemon incorporates the use of musculoskeletal ultrasound in diagnostic evaluations and to assist in the performance of joint and caudal epidural spinal injections. Her use of digital bone densitometry allows her to guide her patients through the treatment of osteoporosis. She is a member of the medical staff of Santa Barbara Cottage Hospital where she provides inpatient consultation to patients suffering from life threatening autoimmune conditions.
