

## BIKE SHIPPING INFORMATION

### Getting your bike to San Francisco from the LA area

#### **Bikes Shipped to San Francisco via McCollister's:**

McCollister's Transportation will collect bikes in the Los Angeles area, fully assembled and unboxed, and will transport them by truck, stored upright and padded, to the Sheraton Hotel in Fisherman's Wharf. When shipping with McCollister's, we recommend that you remove bike computers, water bottles, bike bags and any other personal items from your bike. Bicycles will be well protected, but loose items could fall off and get lost.

To use this service, you must register with McCollister's by **Thursday, September 15th**. There are a variety of ways to reserve your space. Please visit the site below for options and pricing:

2. Click "Household" along the top menu, then select "Bike Ride" from the drop down.
3. Click on the "Arthritis Foundation California Coast Classic Bicycle Tour" link.
4. Review methods of reservations (mail, online, Phone, walk in).
5. Click "Pre Ride Register" to access the form (DO NOT CLICK "POST RIDE REGISTER").
6. When you are asked for your rider number, input "CCC"

All bikes must be dropped off at **McCollister's Warehouse, Fontana** OR **NEW LOCATION!!! Raleigh Bikes in Santa Monica**. **Raleigh is the Official Bike Sponsor of the CCC 2016 Tour!** Be sure to get and keep your re-claim tag when you drop off your bike; you will need it to pick up your bike in San Francisco.

Bikes will only be taken on the following dates and store hours:

- Saturday, September 17 from 10am - 6pm
- Sunday, September 18 from 10am - 5pm
- Monday, September 19 from 10am - 6pm
- Tuesday, September 20 from 10am - 12 noon

**IMPORTANT!**

To reclaim your bike in San Francisco, you must show your driver's license and the re-claim tag you received from McCollister's when you dropped off your bike.

If you do not live in the LA area, or choose not to use McCollister's shipping, and are not able to bring your bike to the start yourself:

You will need to have your bike disassembled, boxed and shipped. Most bike shops will do this for a fee. You can also ship via BikeFlights.com, FedEx or similar shipping companies. Shipments will be accepted at SHERATON HOTEL **ONLY From Tuesday, September 20th to Thursday, September 22nd**. If shipping, make sure your name is inside the box on your bike.

You can also contact the airlines about flying with your bike.

If you want to have your bike reassembled by our bike mechanics, bring your boxed bike to the Sheraton on Friday. A charge of \$25 (cash only) for reassembly will be payable to the mechanic at time of reassembly.

**BIKE BOXES/CASES – WE HAVE LIMITED SPACE (FIRST-COME BASIS) AVAILABLE FOR BIKE CASES ON OUR TRUCKS.** If you wish to have your case transported on our trucks you must email Shannon at [SMarangCox@arthritis.org](mailto:SMarangCox@arthritis.org) to make arrangements before **September 15, based on availability**. Otherwise you will be required to ship the case from San Francisco to the Arthritis Foundation Los Angeles office. It will then be delivered to the Finish Line for you. You will need to arrange for shipment by contacting UPS or FedEx or the concierge at your hotel for advice on how to do this. The Arthritis Foundation Office shipping address is:

**BIKE STORAGE IN SAN FRANCISCO:**

Bike Storage is available at the Sheraton Fisherman's Wharf:

You can pick up your bike (please bring ID) at the hotel during registration hours or from 6-7 am Saturday morning. The hotel is providing secure overnight bike storage the night before the ride. Alternatively, you can store your bike in your room. You will need to ride your bike to the start line on Saturday morning. Directions to the Starting Line will be provided; it is only 5 minutes from the host hotel. Please bring bike lights for the early morning ride!

### Getting your bike home

You will have the option of commissioning our **Finish Line Bike Disassembly, Velo Fix and shipping via BikeFlights.Com**, to break down your bike and ship it via to your home or local bike shop.

If you intend to ship your bike from Finish Line you must:

- Let Shannon know (SMarangCox@arthritis.org)
- Visit BikeFlights.com in advance to make arrangements:
  - Reserve and pay for your return shipment
  - Purchase a box, if you need one
  - Print your shipping label

- Visit the Velo Fix Bike Shipping Area at the Finish Line no later than 3 pm.
- Remove bike computers, water bottles, bike bags and any other personal items from your bike – bicycles will be well protected, but loose items could fall off and get lost.
- Be prepared to pay a fee of \$69 via cash, credit card or PayPal directly to Velo Fix to have your bike broken down and boxed.
- Bikes will be shipped out within 3 business days or earlier if store traffic permits.
