



Bret H. Miller, MD graduated from Baylor University in Waco, Texas and received his medical degree from The University of Texas Medical Branch in Galveston. He transferred his practice of orthopaedics to Southern Illinois in 2010, where he joined Southern Orthopedic Associates, now The Orthopaedic Institute of Southern Illinois. He has served as the Director of Joint Camp services at Herrin Hospital as well as The Chief of Surgical Services. He currently serves as the Orthopaedic Director for Southern Illinois Health Care Orthopaedic Services. He is a Clinical Assistant Professor with SIU's School of Medicine.

Dr. Miller is affiliated with Carbondale Memorial Hospital, Herrin Hospital and Heartland Regional Medical Center. His surgical practice encompasses the breadth of orthopaedics including trauma and sports injuries, however, his experience with adult joint reconstruction leads to a strong concentration in this specialized area of orthopaedics. He has experience with multiple surgical techniques including arthroscopic joint surgery, varied approaches for hip replacement and minimally invasive techniques.
