Primary Objective: Act as a fundraiser and the face for the Walk to Cure Arthritis in the Veteran Community here in Boston.

General Background: The Walk to Cure Arthritis Veteran Honoree is essential to the success of the event. Your role in this event is to help put a face on our mission, and to act as a role model for other Veterans at the event.

Responsibilities:

- Commit to forming a team for the Walk to Cure Arthritis with a fundraising goal of \$5,000
 - Work with your AF Staff Partner to write a plan that helps you reach or exceed your goal
 - Ask friends, family and fellow service members to join your team
 - Goal to recruit 10 team members
 - Ensure that all team members set a goal of at least \$100 and ask their personal networks for donations
- Provide a photo and a one-page biography for use on the event website and in printed materials.
- Serve as Spokesperson for the Boston Walk to Cure Arthritis
 - Share your personal story
 - Promote the event
 - Promote the Arthritis Foundation (with help from staff) and its programs & services available on www.arthritis.org and Walk websites, and who to contact with questions
- Attend and speak (briefly) at the kickoff event – location and date TBD
- Attend the Walk to Cure Arthritis on June 23, 2019
 - Speaking opportunity from the stage.
- Act as a mentor to next year's Walk to Cure Arthritis Veteran Honoree
