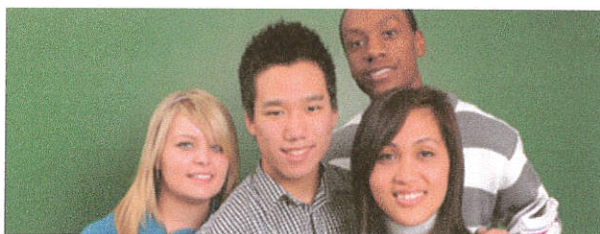
Developing an Effective Plan
