



Marin Headlands Arthritis Bike Classic

FAQ

Q: When is the event?

A. Saturday, July 18, 2015

Q. Where is the Marin Headlands Arthritis Bike Classic held?

A. The event will be held at the College of Marin in Kentfield, CA. We will be at the Physical Education Complex near the baseball field.

Q. How long is the bike route?

A. There are three (3) route lengths available for the same participation fee of \$75.00. We have a 24 mile, 57 mile, and 90 mile route. If at any time you feel this might be a challenging distance for you, we will have a "SAG" van available to help escort you back to the Finish Line.

Q. What if I feel like I can't finish the ride?

A. A designated SAG van will be available to transport tired cyclists back to the finish. You can wait at any official rest stop or landmark for pickup. The van will be marked with official Arthritis Bike Classic signage.

Q. Are Burley carriers or child/infant seats allowed?

A. Yes, all bike carriers are allowed on the 24 mile route. The 57 and 90 mile routes are at rider discretion since there are many tight spaces and greater climbing/elevation involved.

Q. Will there be restrooms along the bike route?

A. Yes, public restrooms will be available for use along the bike route.

Q. Are pets allowed?

A. Yes, on the site, as long as they are kept on a leash at all times. Please also come prepared with proper waste disposal baggies for clean-up. Dogs are not allowed on the bike route due to safety concerns.

Q. Can I turn my donations in at the event?

A. YES! Donations are accepted at the Registration tent beginning at 7:00 AM. If you are a team captain, please come prepared with your envelope printed with the name of each fundraising cyclist's fund designation to ensure proper account crediting.

Q. Is there a fundraising minimum?

A. We do not have a fundraising minimum but ask that all participants commit to raising funds for the Arthritis Foundation. AF staff is available to help support you in your fundraising efforts.

Q. What do I need to do to form a team?

A. All that is needed to form a team is the ability to ask your friends, family, and co-workers to join you and your choice of a team name!

Q. What incentives are there for fundraising beyond the participation fee of \$75.00?

Q. What do I wear?

A. We've ordered a sunny day for the event, but just in case, be prepared for colder weather. Remember, mornings can be chilly in the Bay Area and warm up significantly in the afternoon. We recommend wearing layers as well as bringing sunscreen/sunglasses and your preferred hydration method.

Q. Will there be food at the event?

A. Yes, we will have a continental breakfast in the morning and BBQ lunch in the afternoon.

Q. Will there be activities for children at the event?

A. Yes, we will have an obstacle course, face painting, and balloon artistry for the children both before and after the ride.

Q. Where do I park?

A. Parking is available in the College parking lot adjacent to the site.

Q. Can I collect donations after the event?
