Where is Heartland Community College?

Heartland Community College is located at 1500 West Raab Road in Normal, IL.

How do I get to the Fitness and Recreation Center on HCC'S campus?

Coming from North Main Street and turning left onto Raab Road, turn right onto Millennium Drive (the entrance without the stop light) and the Fitness and Rec Center will be one of the last buildings on your right hand sign.
